

CSTR EDUCATION ASSISTANCE FUND

Education Assistance is available to CSTR members. The assistance program is funded with proceeds from our open pleasure ride held in June each year. We offering education assistance to all junior members, whether or not they have participated in a CSTR ride, as long as they carry a full course load. Assistance will also be offered to adult CSTR members who are furthering their education and following an accredited course.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Recipient must be a current member of CSTR.
- 2. Recipient shall receive \$300.00 per year for college or other further education beyond high school.
- 3. Recipient shall be required to complete a scholarship application each year to receive any additional scholarship awards.
- 4. Additional scholarship awards beyond the first year shall depend upon recipient maintaining passing grades.
- 5. All scholarship awards shall depend upon funds available.
- 6. Completed applications must be mailed by September 1
