- Because of changing Federal Regulations regarding the transportations of horses across state lines, we recommend that you obtain a health certificate and have a certificate of rabies inoculation with you. Please consult your local vet for advice.
- Plan on registering with management as soon as you are set up.

**COVID REQUIREMENTS:** All entrants must be fully vaccinated at least 14 days prior to entry to the field or you will not be admitted to the ride. Please submit a copy of your CDC COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card with your entry form. Please remember to black out your Date of Birth when doing so.

The grounds will be open on Friday June 25, 2021. All riders must be on the grounds by 7 AM on Saturday morning. It is not required that you camp over, but there will be no fee reduction if you do not camp. Ride briefing will be at Breakfast at 8AM and everyone must attend this meeting. Meals are catered. Friday Welcome Pizza Party on Friday Night at 7 pm is included. Saturday meals includes breakfast (8AM) Lunch on trail & in camp and Supper (6:30PM) Sunday includes breakfast 8 AM and lunch after ride. Please plan on keeping paddock size to a minimum (approx 20' x 20')

Welcome Pizza Party on Friday night at 7:00 pm. It is included in the ride fee. We will have Pizza available for your enjoyment. Please bring your own beverages.

#### **From Mass Pike from East or South**

Take Rte 290 north towards Worcester, then straight onto Rte 190 north, Take Exit 2, at end of ramp, go left towards Holden on West Mountain Street, names changes to Doyle Street, then 1.3 miles to a left onto left onto Shewsbury Street. Bear right in 1 mile onto Rte 122A, Then 3.7 miles and bear right on Rte 68, then 10.3 miles to a left on Williamsville Rd, Go approximately 2 1/5 miles to a right on Kruse Rd, Then approximately 1 mile to a right on Root Rd. The field will be approximately a half mile up.

Alternate is to continue up 290 to Route 2 and follow Rte 2 directions below

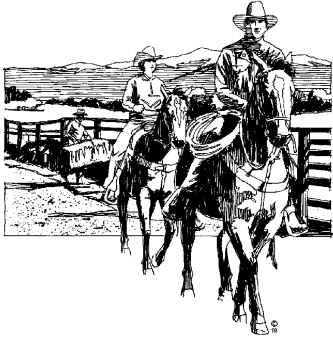
#### **From Mass Pike from West**

From the Mass Pike, take exit for Palmer, and head north towards Barre on Rte 32. In Barre take Rte 62 east to Rte 68 north and follow above from a

left on Williamsville Rd.

#### **From Rte 2 From the East/West**

Take Exit 21 for Route 2A / 101 and head into Templeton. In Templeton, take South Road south, Stay on South Road until it becomes Root Rd and watch for signs for our field on the left
