- This is an unjudged, open pleasure ride, affiliated with New England Horse & Trail Assoc
- Mileage: Saturday's trail will be 15 miles and Sunday will be 10 miles.
- There will be NO driving.
- Bring your own horse & people water.
- Everyone in camp must be registered with the ride and pay the fee.
- Entry registration is for the weekend only
- No Dogs/No Pets -
- Bring Manure bucket and fork to facilitate cleanup
- A negative Coggins Test is required.
- Because of changing Federal Regulations regarding the transportations of horses across state lines, consider obtaining a health certificate and have a certificate of rabies inoculation with you. Please consult your local vet for advice.
- Plan on registering with management as soon as you are set up.

The grounds will be open on Friday June 23. All riders must be on the grounds by 7 AM on Saturday morning. It is not required that you camp over, but there will be no fee reduction if you do not camp. Ride briefing will be at Breakfast at 8 AM and everyone must attend this meeting. Meals are catered. Saturday meals includes breakfast (8AM) Lunch on trail & in camp and Supper (6:30PM) Sunday includes breakfast 8 AM and lunch at 1 pm. Please plan on keeping paddock size to a minimum (approx 20' x 20')

Welcome Pizza Party on Friday night at 7:00 pm is included in the ride fee. We will have Pizza available for your enjoyment. Please bring your own beverages.

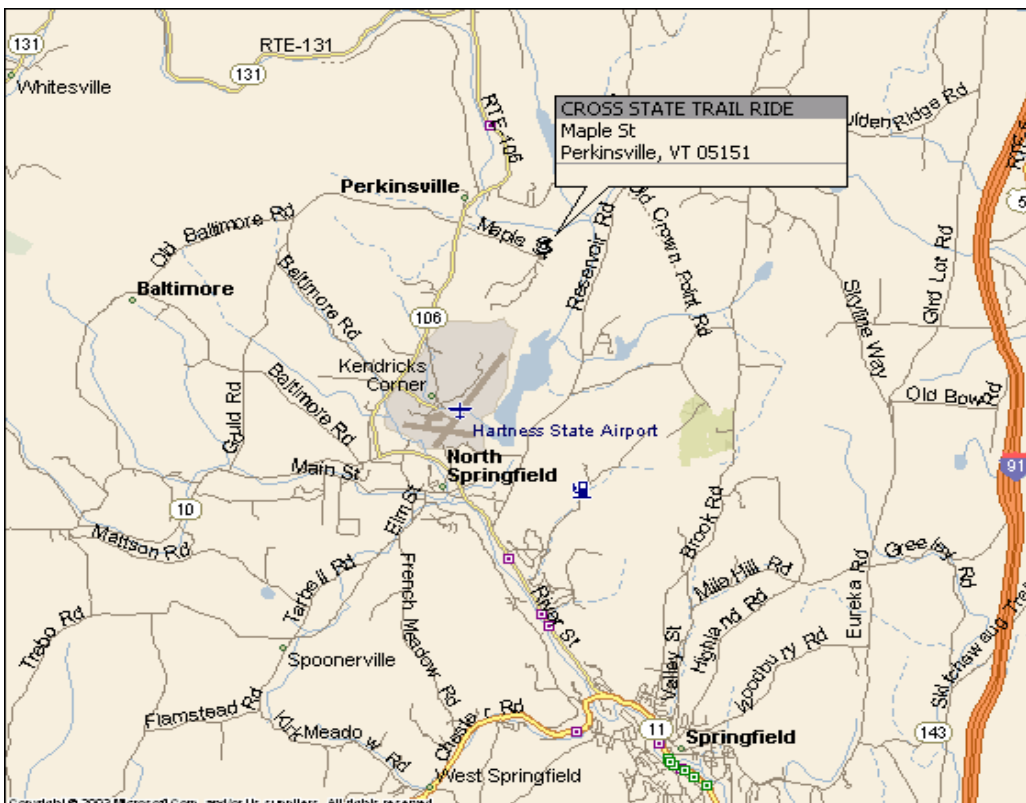
There are a number of ways to get to the CSTR site this year depending on your start point. The North Springfield Lake Project is located in Perkinsville /Weathersfield VT. Our camp is located at the end of Maple Street which is off Rte 106 - a major north/south route in Vermont.

#### FROM RTE 93 NORTH/SOUTH TO RTE 89 THEN 91

- Take Rte 89 North into Vermont, then Rte 91 South. Take Exit 8 for Rte 131 towards Downers Corner. At intersection with Rte 106, take a LEFT or South on Rte 106 for 2 1/2 miles passing Stoughton Pond Rd on the left to a LEFT on Maple Street. Go to the end of Maple Street.

#### ALTERNATE RTE 93 NORTH/SOUTH TO RTE 89 THRU THROUGH CLAREMONT

- Take Rte 89 North to Exit #12 for Rte 11 towards Sunapee/Newport/Claremont. Follow Rte 11 to junction with Rte 103, then continue on Rte 103. In Newport, watch for Rte 103/11 to take a right, then an immediate left around an island, then another right turn, continue on Rte 11/103. In Claremont, watch for a WalMart on your right, then look for a right turn onto Rte 120, in 1/4 mile, at fork, leave Rte 120 and bear left on North Street. Follow to the end and take a right on Rte 103/12. Cross VT State Line, the Connecticut River and go straight on VT Rte 131, crossing under Rte 91. Stay on Rte 131 to a left onto Rte 106 at Downers. Follow into Perkinsville and take a Left on Maple Street.



Follow Rte 11 to junction with Rte 103, then continue on Rte 103. In Newport, watch for Rte 103/11 to take a right, then an immediate left around an island, then another right turn, continue on Rte 11/103. In Claremont, watch for a WalMart on your right, then look for a right turn onto Rte 120, in 1/4 mile, at fork, leave Rte 120 and bear left on North Street. Follow to the end and take a right on Rte 103/12. Cross VT State Line, the Connecticut River and go straight on VT Rte 131, crossing under Rte 91. Stay on Rte 131 to a left onto Rte 106 at Downers. Follow into Perkinsville and take a Left on Maple Street.

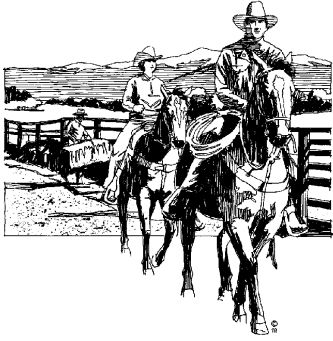
#### FROM POINTS SOUTH

- Take Rte 91 North to exit #7 and take Rte 11 North for 4.7 miles to Springfield and the intersection with Rte 106 North - go 5.7 miles and look for Weathersfield School on the Left and Maple Street will be on the Right

#### ALTERNATE ROUTE FROM SOUTHERN NH

- TAKE Rte 101 out of Nashua to Keene and take Rte 12 North to Charlestown and take Rte 11 towards Vermont, cross Rte 91 and follow above

When you get to the end of Maple Street, the pavement ends . At fork, take a left and follow to end, look for barway on right and enter grounds.
